An additional form for each applicant should be completed. If under the age of 18 a waiver, which can be obtained from the Hon Secretary, signed by a parent or legal guardian, must accompany this application. Reduced subscription rates are payable for anyone whilst unemployed or in full time education. Proof of status or details of college/course attended should be submitted with this form.

A large part of the subscription is for BCA public liability insurance which is required if actively caving; and to maintain the clubs civil liability insurance cover. This is payable on a per member basis. If you belong to another club that provides cover under the same scheme a reduced subscription is payable. Contact the Secretary if you need clarification.
